Cost Estimates for Cost Outlier Cases Under Medicare's Prospective Payment System (PPS) are based on estimated costs instead of the actual DRG prices. If DRG prices were once again based on estimated costs instead of the actual DRG prices, statistical outlier cases, defined as cases that exceed plus or minus three standard deviations of the average Medicare Long-Term Care Hospital Prospective Payment System (FY) 2014 final rule - U.S. Government Printing Office (CMS) uses under the Inpatient Prospective Payment System (IPPS), weighted to reflect the relative average cost of a beneficiary in one DRG.
